**SUBJECT: ADMISSION TO BAMS AND BHMS COURSES- IN AYURVEDIC AND HOMOEOPATHIC INSTITUTES SITUATED IN THE STATE OF PUNJAB-2011 ONWARDS.**

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In partial modification in Notification No. 5/3/2011-3HB-III/3315 dated 12.05.2011 for admission in BAMS / BHMS courses, the para 1.3 and para 3.d is hereby replaced / added as under :-

- 3.1 That admission to BAMS / BHMS courses should be made as per PAET merit only. Candidate not appearing in PAET should not be considered for admission.
- 3.d. "15% seats shall be open to candidate who have studied 10+1 and 10+2 examination or equivalent examination with Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English as regular students from a recognized institution from any where in the country. However, if the requisite numbers of eligible qualified candidates are not available under 85% quota, the vacant seats shall be transferred to 15% quota and vice versa."




